Selection Criteria:

- Demonstrates participation within the broad umbrella of the Asian American Pacific Islander Community as a member, ally or supporter.
- A desire to grow personal skills in the areas of career development, networking, financial literacy and becoming board-ready.
- Commitment to attend and fully engage in all four courses of the program.

Program Schedule:

The ACFC Leadership Development Program runs 6pm- 8pm on: 03/23, 03/30, 04/6, 04/13, 04/20 and 04/27. We ask that you confirm your availability to attend these six sessions prior to applying to the program. If you are unable to attend all six please consider postponing to a later session of the program when you are available. We will not be able to provide certificates or alum benefits to individuals who do not complete at minimum 5 classes.

Tuition:

The tuition for the ACFC Leadership Development Program will be waived for the 2022 session. Participants are responsible for their own travel to sessions, which will be held at the American Red Cross building on 444 Sherman St. in Denver CO. Meals will be provided and stipends can be awarded for individuals who show that commuting to classes will be a burden.
